Thursday, March 26, 2009

A Board of Supervisors meeting convened at 8:45 a.m. with all members present. Also present was Charlie Pajer. Motion by Voaklander, second by Walk to include discuss lighting at County Services building and to approve the amended agenda. All voted aye.

County Engineer Jim Hyde reported on the Secondary Road construction program and the five year road plan. The Road budget will be turned into the State by the end of next week.

Motion by Walk, second by Voaklander to authorize the Chair to sign the Iowa Department of Human Services Community Mental Health Center affiliation form. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Discussed the interior hall security lights of the County Service building. When the building was built the lights were wired to be on twenty-four hours a day. In order to conserve on utility costs the County will check with an electrician on having a switch installed to turn the lights off when the building is not open.
