ORDINANCE NO. 21B

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE
ESTABLISHING VOTING DISTRICTS
IN MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA:

1.02 Districts Defined. That the voting districts in Mitchell shall be as follows:

District #1: First District is located within Osage Township and is described as starting on East side of Osage City Limits and Hwy. 9/218, go East to March Avenue, then North to 370th St., then West to Hwy. 218, then North to Osage Township line; then West to Kirkwood Ave.; then South on Kirkwood to 370th St.; then West on Osage Township line; then follow Osage Township line South and East to Lancer Avenue; then go North to Osage City limits and then follow Osage City limits East and North to point of beginning. This district includes all of the City of Osage. First District according to the 2000 Census – 3631.

District #2: Second District shall consist of the following townships: Rock, Mitchell, Newburg, St. Ansgar, and Otranto; along with Cedar Township except that part located at a point starting on Lancer Avenue and shared township line of Osage and Cedar and go South to 340th St.; then East to West boundary of West Lincoln Township line; and in Union Township those sections West of Lancer Ave. and that part of Osage Township that is North of 370th St. and West of Kirkwood Ave.
Towns included in this district are St. Ansgar, Carpenter and Mitchell. Second District according to the 2000 Census – 3631.

District #3: Third District shall consist of the following townships: West Lincoln, East Lincoln, Douglas, Burr Oak, Liberty, Jenkins, Stacyville, Wayne and in Union Township those sections East of Lancer Ave.; and land located in Osage Township as follows: starting at a point on Hwy. 218 and Osage Township line, go South to 370th St., then go East to March Ave., then South to Hwy. 9/218, then West to Osage City Limits and follow city limits South and West to Lancer Ave., and South to Osage Township line; and also include that part of Cedar Township that is located East of a line starting from a point on Lancer Ave. and Cedar/Osage Township Line go South to 340th St., then East to the West Boundary of West Lincoln Township line. Towns included in this district are McIntire, Orchard, Riceville and Stacyville. Third District according to the 2000 Census – 3612.

Precinct Descriptions – 2000 Census

Precinct #1: Contains all of Liberty Township and Burr Oak Township.

Precinct #2: Contains all of Cedar West Township and all of Cedar East Township, except that part North and East, starting at a point on Lancer Ave. and shared Osage/Cedar Township line, go South to 340th St., then go East to the West boundary of West Lincoln Township.

Precinct #3: Contains all of Douglas Township and all of East Lincoln Township.

Precinct #4: Contains all of Jenkins Township, which includes that part of the City of Riceville located in Mitchell County.

Precinct #5: Contains all of Rock Township, Mitchell Township and that portion of Osage Township located West of Kirkwood Ave. and North of 370th St., and includes the City of Mitchell.

Precinct #6: Contains all of West Lincoln Township and that part of Cedar Township located East of a line starting at a point located on Lancer Ave. and shared Osage/Cedar Township line, go South to 340th St., then East to the West Boundary of West Lincoln; and also includes that part of Osage Township located East of a line starting at a point on Highway 218 and 380th St., then go South on Highway 218 to 370th St., then East to March Ave., then South on March Ave. to Highway 218/9, then West to City limits of Osage, then follow Osage City limits South and West to Lancer Ave., then go South to Osage Township line.

Precinct #7: Located in Osage Township and includes Ward #1 of City of Osage, and starting at a point located on N. 10th St. and Osage City Limits, go North to 370th St., then East to March Ave., then South to Highway 9/218 and then West to Osage City limits.

Precinct #8: Located in Osage Township and includes Ward #2 of City of Osage, and starting at a point located on N. 10th St. and Osage City Limits, go North to 370th St., then West to Highway 218, then North to 380th St., then West to Kirkwood Ave., then go South to 370th St., then West to West boundary of Osage Township, then South to Highway 9, then go East on Highway 9 to Osage City Limits.

Precinct #9: Located in Osage Township and includes Ward #3 of City of Osage, and starting at a point located with Osage City limits and Highway 9, go West to West boundary of Osage Township, then follow Osage Township line South and East to Lancer Ave., then go North to Osage City Limits.

Precinct #10: Located in Osage Township and is contained within same boundaries as Ward #4 in City of Osage.

Precinct #11: Contains all of Otranto Township and Newburg Townships, which includes the city of Carpenter.

Precinct #12: Contains all of St. Ansgar Township and Union Township, except that part of Union Township located East of Lancer Ave. This precinct includes the City of St. Ansgar.

Precinct #13: Contains all of Stacyville Township and that part of Union Township located East of Lancer Ave. This precinct includes the City of Stacyville.

Precinct #14: Contains all of Wayne Township, which includes the city of McIntire.

WHEREAS, certain deviations and standards must be met according to Iowa Code Section 42.4, these are the deviations:

Total Mitchell County census, 10,874 according to the 2000 census.
Ideal size of supervisor's districts – 3,624.

First District census	3,631 – 3,624 (ideal) = + 7
Second District census	3,631 – 3,624 (ideal) = + 7
Third District census	3,612 – 3,624 (ideal) = <u>-12</u>

Total deviation from ideal 26

There is no district that deviates from the 1% of the ideal district.

The overall deviation is not in excess of the 1% of total census.

The largest district divided by the smallest = 1.0052602 and therefore meets that criteria.

ENACTMENT AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This enactment shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption as provided by law.
