

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Friday, December 21, 2018

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Barb Francis, Russ Brandau, Gloria Brincks and Crystal Berche (Media). Motion by Voaklander, second by Smolik to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Smolik, second by Voaklander to approve the claims. Roll call vote: all vote aye.

County Sheriff Greg Beaver reviewed the November Sheriff's Report. Motion by Voaklander, second by Smolik to approve the report in the amount of \$8,792.35. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Motion by Smolik, second by Voaklander to approve Resolution #1023-18 adopting the Compensation Board's FY 2020 salary recommendations. Roll call vote: all ayes.

After discussion, motion by Smolik, second by Voaklander to approve a 3% wage increase with a .50 cent per hour minimum for the hourly county employees. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Auditor Tesch stated that the 2019 school and city elections will be combined and be held the first Tuesday of November. Auditors thru out the State are discussing procedures on how to distribute the cost of the election in a equitable way to the schools and the cities.

Supervisor Walk administered the oath of office to Supervisor Elect Barb Francis.
