Tuesday, July 7, 2020

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Samantha Scharper and Dave Stauffer. Present from the media was Steve Thompson. Due to the COVID 19 the meeting was made available to the public by video via “Go to Meeting” Motion by Smolik, second by Walk to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

County Attorney Mark Walk had nothing to report.

Sheriff Greg Beaver reported on the 4th of July weekend. He stated that some people who shot off fireworks had left their refuse along the side of the roadways. Discussed the old Sheriff pickup. The County Engineer may be interested in using it as his work truck.

County Engineer Rich Brumm discussed wage and benefit package options for the Assistant County Engineer position.

Items of note: Smolik reported on the FMC Landfill Executive Board meeting. Received manure management plan updates from Junction South, Emery Unruh, Iowa Select – Kiss/Tip 13 Wean Finish, Iowa Select – Johnson Tip 6 Nursery Unit, Liberty East Finisher Farm, Liberty West Finisher Farm, Liberty South Finisher Farm, Blong South Finisher Farm, Jenkins North Finisher Farm and Jenkins South Finisher Farm. Supervisor Walk advised the Board to watch future declining LOSST Funds and Gas Tax Funds due to the impact of COVID 19.
